

Lead Team Covenant

Lead Team is for students who are serious about leading in the CRBC HSM. Lead Team students are committed to Christ and the church, make disciples, and find ways to lead in the way that God has gifted them. Lead Team students take serious the attitude of Christ by leading in a servanthood method. Lead Team is also the way in which a student can attend super summer, participate in the student band, attend an out of country mission trip.

Commitment:

- Be at 75% of Sunday and Wednesday (Starts sept. 13th)
- Be actively encouraging other students and friends to be involved in student ministry
- Read through the Lead Team Book
- Attend monthly Lead Team Meeting on Sunday Nights

Discipleship:

- Actively disciple a younger student, or be disciplined by older student.
 - Discipleship time will be given every 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month, but can happen outside of this time.
- Meet with Landry once a semester (encouragement, prayer, and see how I can help.)

Leadership:

- Lead by your example in small groups
- Be apart of at least one planning team (Big Weekend, Camp, Sunday and Wednesday)
- Find people you do not know and interact with them at service

As a Lead Team Member, you are to be an example in your speech, your lifestyle, your love for God and others, your attitude of faith and in your moral purity.

"Don't let anyone think less of you because you are young. Be an example to all believers in what you say, in the way you live, in your love, your faith, and your purity...Give your complete attention to these matters. Throw yourself into your tasks so that everyone will see your progress. Keep a close watch on how you live and on your teaching. ³ Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. ⁴ Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too.

⁵ You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had.

as something to cling to.
⁷ Instead, he gave up his divine privileges*;
he took the humble position of a slave*
and was born as a human being.
When he appeared in human form,*
⁸ he humbled himself in obedience to God
and died a criminal's death on a cross.
